



Announcing a new venture – BATPSG

Bucks Adlerian Training is developing its support for 3rd, 4th and 5th year students who are completing or have completed their 450 training hours, and who are making up their supervised one-to-one client hours within placements.

We have formed the **Bucks Adlerian Training Placement Support Group** which is for students who are under formal supervision by an Adlerian Supervisor for their client hours, and feel they would benefit from meeting with their peers once every 6 weeks, for two hours on a Saturday afternoon in Milton Keynes. We have managed to get this venue free of charge which is an enormous help, so costs will be minimal.

Whilst informal, this peer support group will form a contract, to include confidentiality. It is not to be used in lieu of formal Adlerian supervision, and we hope it will be a useful and creative opportunity for BAT students to meet and support each other in their placements.

One of the BAT Tutors will attend one session every 6 months to support, encourage and ensure the group is working effectively.
