This an opportunity to explore experiences and uncover personal and professional knowledge that we/you and our clients, all develop in the unique contexts in which we all work. Our interest is to understand our influence as Adlerian practitioners and how and why we achieve it.

- We can uncover what is really important and what motivates us in how we act.
- We can learn from each other while understanding and improving our Adlerian practice in our various fields.
- We can evaluate our influence and build explanations that can be shared beyond the group.
- In this way individual explanations of practitioner knowledge, collaboratively generated, can contribute to the Adlerian psychology knowledge-base.
- Through Skype we will be returning to Adler's conversation cafe style in Vienna where he and others developed their theories in conversation with other practitioners.
- We will use Living Educational Theory methodology specifically developed for practitioners to create valid explanations of their practice <http://www.actionresearch.net/>. This will be practice knowledge which cannot be found anywhere else, because it is context dependent.
