- A contact e-mail address and telephone number.
- A clear statement of the topic to be covered and a summary of key points.
- If you are describing research, the abstract should follow a conventional structure (aim, methods ,results, discussion and conclusion), and should include a summary of findings. Research presentations will be accepted on the understanding that appropriate ethical standards will have been adhered to.
- For workshops, please include information about objectives and teaching approaches.

The aim is to provide a platform for attendees to contribute using their extensive knowledge and experience, and to encourage participation and constructive discussion of material presented.

Posters: Each poster having A1 space allocated for presentation
